### Re: Discriminatory Grantmaking at Department of Health and Human Services

Dear Secretary Kennedy and Director Stannard:

The Equal Protection Project of the Legal Insurrection Foundation, a non-profit that, among other things, seeks to ensure equal protection under the law and opposes unlawful discrimination in any form, submits this letter to alert you to discriminatory grantmaking practices at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and to request that changes be made to bring these programs into compliance with the law and administration policy.

Through a review of publicly available databases, we have identified three (3) HHS grant programs that require recipients to implement discriminatory selection criteria. These grants are listed in **Exhibit A**. Based on publicly available information, these programs appear to be active.

These practices violate the federal civil rights laws and constitutional guarantees of equal protection, including Title VI and the Fifth Amendment. Such practices also violate Executive

Order 14173<sup>1</sup>, which, among other directives, requires executive departments to eliminate racial and other unlawful preferences:

- Sec. 2. *Policy*. It is the policy of the United States to protect the civil rights of all Americans and to promote individual initiative, excellence, and hard work. I therefore order all executive departments and agencies (agencies) to terminate all discriminatory and illegal preferences, mandates, policies, programs, activities, guidance, regulations, enforcement actions, consent orders, and requirements. I further order all agencies to enforce our longstanding civil-rights laws and to combat illegal private-sector DEI preferences, mandates, policies, programs, and activities.
- Sec. 4. Encouraging the Private Sector to End Illegal DEI Discrimination and Preferences. (a) The heads of all agencies, with the assistance of the Attorney General, shall take all appropriate action with respect to the operations of their agencies to advance in the private sector the policy of individual initiative, excellence, and hard work identified in section 2 of this order.

We urge your office to take immediate action to bring these discriminatory programs into compliance with the law and administration policy.




